Objectives of the training

Prospects of the training

- Wood Apple (*Feronia Limonia*) and Bael (*Aegle marmelos*) are native to India and are rich in anti-oxidants, vitamins, minerals and dietary fibre.
- Cultivated/Improved varieties of wood apple & Bael are sweet and the fresh ripe pulp is used for preparation of value added products which have high demand due to health benefits.
- Wood apple fruit is used for curative properties and ripe and unripe fruits are used for preparing value added products.
- Both crops have bright prospects of cultivation in India due to its ability to grow well under the waste land and problematic soil conditions.
- By products utilisation of wood apple shell powder for making biodegradable products.

- Training imparts Hands-on training on preparation of various processed products from Wood apple and Bael fruits which can be taken up as an entrepreneurial activity.
- Training imparts detailed know how on improved varieties, propagation and cultivation aspects to realise high productivity and income.
